## Potential USCDC Subcommittees for 2018-2019

1. INTER-COMMUNITY OUTREACH/PARTNERSHIPS  
The purpose of this subcommittee is to develop partnerships with other Democratic committees, especially those in the South Hills, and other groups who share Democratic beliefs.
2. LECTURE SERIES  
The USCDC will sponsor a lecture series to provide Upper St. Clair residents and other interested parties with information about critical topics that impact members of our community.
3. FINANCE/FUNDRAISING.  
The USCDC will raise funds to financially support the USCDC and local candidates in their election bid.
4. NEWSLETTER  
In order to keep USC Democrats informed, promote the activities of the Party, and engage all interested constituents, the USCDC will publish a periodic newsletter.
5. ANNUAL PICNIC  
In order to engage USC Democrats and solicit new members, the USCDC will hold an annual picnic.
6. COMMUNITY DAY  
In order to engage USC Democrats and solicit new members the USCDC will participate in the annual USC Community Day.
7. RECRUITMENT  
To locate and assist interested qualified Democrats to be elected for local offices including district and ward committee positions, commissioners, and school board.
8. OUTREACH  
The USC Outreach subcommittee will develop strategies and implement plans to recruit new committee representatives and members in order to grow the Democratic party in USC.
9. ELECTIONS  
This subcommittee will identify the best means to get out the Democratic vote and to support the polling effort including the recruitment and training of election watchers.
10. DATA MINING
